



## COVID 19 FIRST AID INSTRUCTIONS AND EQUIPMENT

The following first aid equipment should be stored in the Hall isolation room:

- Face mask (covering) & pair of plastic gloves x 2 – each set in a plastic bag (for responder and patient)
- Plastic face shield – for the responder
- Pocket pack of tissues
- Hand soap in pump dispenser
- Paper towels
- Small hand sanitiser gel
- Disposable apron e.g. plastic sleeveless or cheap overalls
- Small packet anti-bacterial wipes
- Rubbish bags x 2 (so disposables can be double-bagged). The outer one marked e.g. “Covid Waste”.
- Washing up bowl for handwashing
- A plastic chair(s) for the suspected COVID 19 patient(s).

As soon as a victim(s) have been identified and isolated the responder should contact NHS Direct on 111 and ask for further guidance. The hirer is to contact the Hall Managers on 01980 671087.

The responder should put on a mask, face shield, gloves and apron to protect themselves. Once the affected person has left remove all PPE and double bag in the labelled bags provided. Wash hands, when home launder your clothes and wipe down your vehicle.

If advised to do so send the affected person(s) home immediately.

Inform those at the activity and send them home (ensuring they have left their track and trace details with the hirer). Advise all attending to launder their clothes.

All hall users are made aware of these requirements when they first use the facilities.
